

2023 – 2024 Off Season Update

Dear Two River Little League (TRLL) Community,

We hope everyone had a great holiday and Happy New Year! **Registration is OPEN in all 5** of our TRLL towns through January 31st, so please sign-up today through your town's recreation site. Spring is around the corner and we're looking forward to another great Little League baseball and softball season in 2024.

Here are some key dates to keep in mind for the upcoming season:

- **Practices** will likely begin towards the end of March
- *Regular season games* will begin when schools return from Spring Break (on or around April 8th) and will run for 7 full weeks until May 24th
- **Playoffs** (for ages 9U and up) will begin May 28th and run through June 8th
- **All Star district little league tournaments** for selected players (ages 9U thru 12U) typically begin the third week of June and wrap up early July (note these are double elimination tourneys, so dates can be shorter or longer depending on how teams do)

In terms of fun events for the spring season, please plan on the following:

- Jersey Shore BlueClaws Night: TRLL is planning to have our 6th annual Two River Little League night at the Jersey Shore BlueClaws in Lakewood, scheduled for <u>Thursday</u> <u>May 2nd</u>. No games will be scheduled across TRLL that night. More details will follow.
- *High School Baseball & Softball Games (Bulldogs vs. Bucs):* Following successful events the last two years, please have our TRLL kids come out to support their local high school teams and TRLL alumni as they square off in the Battle of Ridge Road:
 - Varsity softball Sat Apr 13th (RBR @ RFH)
 - Varsity baseball Sat May 18th (RBR @ RFH)

A big "Thank you" to Fair Haven's **Brad Weisgerber** who was a long-standing TRLL volunteer board member in charge of finance and treasury activities for our league. Brad did an amazing job of organizing all finance and budgeting work, while ensuring our kids are able to enjoy this wonderful sport at a reasonable fee by keeping expenses lean and supporting fundraising efforts (i.e. BlueClaws night). As Brad's children age out of TRLL, he is stepping aside and a new volunteer from Fair Haven will be announced shortly.
